Bay Area Educational Theater Company is currently rehearsing for our production of **Peter Pan**. Bay Area e.T.c. is offering activity coordinators the opportunity to expose older adults to a quality live theatrical production at a reduced price. Your participants can benefit in many ways by attending a quality theatrical production.

Our company consists of performers, volunteers and professionals from all over the Bay Area. Our performers range in age from six to adult and participate in workshops for nearly four months. They receive training in acting, dancing and voice, which culminates in the final production. We are pleased to be able to offer special weekday performances as follows:

Thursday, **May 1 10:00 a.m.**

Thursday, **May 15 10:00 a.m.**

Groups of ten or more will receive a discounted price of **\$5.00 per ticket**. In addition, we allow one chaperone for every ten paying participants to attend at no charge. The show runs approximately 2 hours with a 10-15 minute break. *Please note that no food or drinks will be allowed inside the theater.*

Tickets are sold in advance to accommodate group size and schedules. It is important to make your reservations early. We will try our best to accommodate your first date choice. *We invite you to share this letter and attached reservation form with your co-workers.*

This spring, our production will be performed at the Canada College Main Stage Theater at 4200 Farm Hill Blvd. in Redwood City.

From Highway 280: Take the Farm Hill Blvd. exit, and turn left at the stoplight into the campus.

From Highway 101 (traveling North or South): Take the Woodside exit (northbound travelers turn left; southbound travelers turn right). Drive west about three miles to Hwy. 280 and head north toward San Francisco on Highway 280. Take the Farm Hill Blvd. exit right and turn left at the stoplight into the campus.

From El Camino Real (traveling North or South): Turn onto Jefferson Ave. (northbound travelers turn left; southbound travelers turn right). Jefferson becomes Farm Hill Blvd., and at the stoplight into campus, turn right.

Just a note to drivers: anyone who parks any motor vehicle on campus during day and evening hours is required to have a parking permit. A daily permit may be purchased with 4 quarters or a \$1 bill in coin-operated dispensers located near the student parking areas.
